SMART GOAL EXAMPLE

- 1. **Specific**: By the end of the semester, students will increase their ability to use technology tools for math by 50%.
- 2. **Measurable:** Students will demonstrate competency of usage of technology through formative and summative assessments.
- 3. **Achievable**: Students will be provided with targeted instruction and opportunities to practice with real-life problem solving.
- 4. **Realistic:** Enhancing technology tools in math is crucial for overall academic success in future opportunities for education and work.
- 5. **Timely**: The goal will be achieved by the end of the current semester.
